The Scannx **Scan-to-Translate** service enables users to instantly translate printed documents in English, French, Italian, German, and Spanish into another 60+ text languages and a fewer number of audio languages without having to manually retype the text into a separate document or online conversion tool. Scanned documents are securely uploaded to Microsoft® or Google translation services. Scannx sends both original text and translated text to email, USB or Google Drive in Word file format (DOCX) for editing, if required. Existing Scannx customers under a Software Assurance Agreement can try the service free for 30 days.

Scannx's new tool also provides service organizations with usage statistics that can help them better understand language requirements in their communities. Scannx Cloud Services reports provide details on number of pages for both the original language scanned and the translation language selected. In addition, the Scannx software works with major coin, bill and credit card payment systems, enabling cost recovery options for organizations that provide critical digital document amenities for their constituents.

Organizations such as libraries, schools, government agencies and commercial organizations can provide the functionality to its general public through Scannx self-service book and document ScanCenter kiosks. Microsoft Translate supports 63 text languages, and Google Translate offers 104 text languages.

Translating content into just the world's top 10 languages (Chinese, English, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Portuguese, Russian, Spanish and Turkish) is estimated to cover almost 80% of the spoken languages. The top 5 languages will be able to reach more than 60% of its global footprint.
